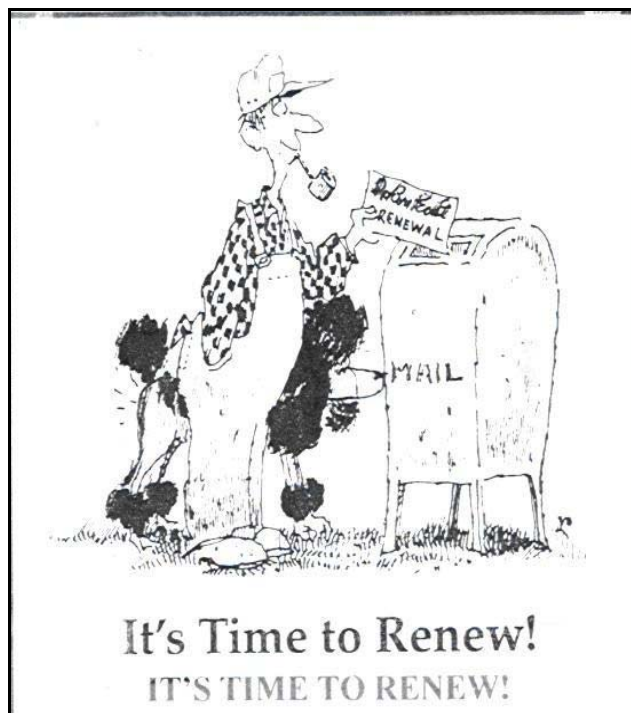

Their leading some of the other dogs down the hall to the big steel door. I think that means they are going home, and they must be so happy.

Now that the puppies are gone they say I will be next. I think that means I'll be going home. I wish I could see my puppies again before I leave. I guess I don't have time.....They are here to take me home.

Addendum; This is the true story of a Miniature Poodle in a Central Maine Humane Shelter (it could be in your home town), though it could easily have been a Toy or Standard Poodle, or any other breed, that was purchased from unknowledgable or uncaring breeders, sold to unknowledgable and uncaring buyers.

The morel of the story is;

Breeders must only breed dogs that are proper in looks, and type, for their breed. Be sure that those you sell to, know what to expect of the breed you are selling to them. Do not sell *pets* to **ANY ONE** who *will not spay or neuter their dog.* .

Buyer; do not purchase a *pet dog* without having it spaye, or neutered, *before it is six months old.* If the breeder does not insist it be neutered, **DO NOT** buy from such an uncaring breeder.

I also called the AKC and asked if there has ever been a RED Standard Poodle to achieve a Hunting Title, She researched it and I called back a couple days later and she said, "NO" there has not been one.

Cooper's Great Grandfather is **CH Majestic Red Rogan**, the 1st RED to achieve his conformation Championship in the USA. Pretty Cool huh?

We are so proud of him and we have 2 females that are following in his footsteps that we hope to get a hunting title on soon. We are going to also go for the AKC JH title in the spring !!

Rules Applying to Dog Shows

Any person acting in the capacity of Match Secretary at a match, or any member of his immediate household or immediate family (as defined in Chapter 11, Sections 12 & 13 of the *Rules Applying to Dog Shows*), shall not exhibit, act as agent or handler at the match, and dogs owned wholly or in part by him or by any member of his immediate household or immediate family shall be ineligible to be entered at that match.

No judge or any person residing in the same household with a judge shall exhibit or act as agent or handler at a match at which he is officiating as judge and dogs owned wholly or in part by such judge or any member of his household shall be ineligible to be entered at such match. Subject to the foregoing, members of a judge's immediate family who no longer reside in the same household may enter or handle a dog at a match if the judge is not officiating over any competition, including a group class or best in match, for which the dog is entered or may become eligible.

REMOVING TEAR STAINS

Here's what we use to clean the tear stains off of the Persian's faces (and it works on poodles, too- **warning, do not get IN the eyes of any animal!**):

- 1 cup distilled water
- 3 cc Tylan (I usually leave this out)
- 1/4 cup witch hazel
- 1 tablespoon boric acid

Keep it in the fridge and it will last a long time. Apply with cotton balls, always wiping AWAY from the eye.

Deep Stain Paste:

Above liquid (no tylen), milk of magnesia, cornstarch to make a paste. Put on stained fur and let dry. Brush it out and the stain will at least be much lighter. Repeated applications will remove red stains. It can be used anywhere on the body to remove stains on light hair. (Thanks to Deb Hersey for this)

I have a lot of Bichon and Maltese customers with runny eyes. This works on 90% of them, even the vet was surprised.

Pan Mycen Aqua Drops. They are given orally. They are given 3 x's a day, I use a dropper full for a Bichon size and about 3/4 for a Maltese.

It is a tetracycline, a lot of vet's will say well here's the ointment, or here's the pill, not the same. I sold a puppy to a human eye Dr. I showed him the box. He almost cried and said they took it off the human market. He ordered boxes for his customers and even showed it to a few doctors at Wills Eye Clinic in Phila. It is back on the market for humans and they are elated.

It takes the bacteria out of the tears, that makes the stain. You need a prescription for it, introduce it to your vet, they will love you. (From a groomer friend in PA.)

Remember that many times the tearing is caused by hair from the poodles face growing long enough to touch the eyes, there by causing conjunctivitis (eye infection).

The solution is to keep the face trimmed..
