Dog Gone Good Recipes

No Grain Poodle Biscuits

2 jars baby food meat (your choice of favor)
 2 jars of toddler mixed vegetables or substitute frozen mixed veggies
 2 eggs
 garlic
 1/4 cup parmesan cheese
 Instant mashed potatoes
 Extra Parmesan cheese , left-

over gravy.

Mix together meat, vegetables , eggs, garlic and cheese. Smash the vegetables a bit but leave them coarse. Add enough instant potatoes until a stiff dough forms. Roll out the dough and cut with poodle shaped cookie cutter (or other shape) Brush each cookie with leftover gravy and sprinkle with cheese.

Bake in a low heat oven 225 degrees until done. Biscuits are done when they are hard to the touch. Turn off oven and let sit in warm oven for additional 30mins. To insure they are completely dry and crunchy. Store in air tight container when completely cooled.
